

During the 18th and 19th centuries, personal diaries played a significant role in constructing a modern subjectivity that emphasized the application of reason and critique to comprehend both the world and oneself. They offered a private space where one could write daily about their thoughts, feelings, and whereabouts. With time and rereading, these disparate entries, events, and happenstances could be transformed into insights and narratives about the self, leading to the formation of subjectivity. This is where the concept of "the self [as] both made and explored with words" emerges. Diaries were personal and private, where individuals would write for themselves or, in Habermas's formulation, make oneself public to oneself. By making the self public in a private sphere, individuals could objectify the self for selfinspection and self-critique.

Urban delivery vehicles can be modified to better accommodate the needs of densely populated areas by utilizing smaller transportation options like vans or bicycles. Bicycles, in particular, have the potential to become a popular choice for lastmile deliveries, especially in crowded and congested regions. In countries with high bicycle usage, such as the Netherlands, delivery bicycles are also employed for transporting personal cargo like groceries. Cargo bicycles offer significant potential in both developed and developing nations due to their low purchase and upkeep expenses, as demonstrated by the Indonesian becak, a three-wheeled bike. Electrically assisted delivery tricycles have been effectively introduced in France and are progressively being embraced throughout Europe for various services, including parcel and catering deliveries. The use of bicycles as cargo vehicles is particularly recommended in combination with policies that limit motor vehicle access to specific city areas, like downtown or commercial districts, or with the expansion of dedicated bike lanes.

If car manufacturers must assess and disclose vehicle safety features, potential buyers can weigh safety against other factors like cost and design. Providing calorie details to restaurant patrons enables those seeking weight loss to utilize the data, while not affecting those unconcerned with calorie intake. Disclosure should not only avoid hindering but also enhance the autonomy and quality of personal decision-making.



Distinct regions of the brain's visual system obtain information based on their specific needs. Cells that aid hand muscles in reaching for an object must be aware of the object's size and location, but not its color. They require some understanding of the object's shape, though not in high detail. In contrast, cells responsible for recognizing faces need to be extremely sensitive to the nuances of shape, while the importance of location is diminished. It is a common belief that when someone sees an object, they perceive all its aspects, such as shape, color, location, and movement. However, the reality is that different parts of the brain process these aspects separately – one area perceives shape, another processes color, a third determines location, and yet another detects movement. Consequently, after experiencing localized brain damage, it is possible for someone to perceive specific aspects of an object while being unable to discern others. Centuries ago, people had difficulty understanding how someone could see an object without recognizing its color. Even in the present day, it may be surprising to discover that there are individuals who can see an object without being able to identify its location or ascertain whether it is in motion.

Luhmann conducted research on various topics, such as mass media and law. Despite the challenge of translating his books, they have been extensively translated into multiple languages.

Examining interactions on the dancefloor offers numerous illustrative instances of how individuals modify their behavior in reaction to local information

As an example, when honeybees carrying water return to the hive, they seek out a receiver bee to transfer their water load within the colony. If the search time is brief, the returning bee is more likely to perform a waggle dance, recruiting others to the water source. On the other hand, if the search time is lengthy, the bee may abandon water collection. Since receiver bees only accept water when needed, either for themselves or to distribute to other bees and brood, this unloading time correlates with the colony's overall water requirement. Consequently, an individual water forager's response to unloading time (increasing or decreasing) adjusts water collection according to the colony's needs. [3]
